GENERAL

| 1 | Unless otherwise stated each game will last a minimum of 6 minutes one-way. |
| 2 | Players can play for one team only - that is the team they are registered with. |
| 3 | Clubs with more than one team in the tournament may not rotate players between teams. |
| 4 | All players must be under the relevant age as of 31 st august 2009. |
| 5 | Any player sent off will take no further part in the tournament. |
| 6 | In the event of a penalty shoot-out, only players that were on the pitch at the end of the game are eligible to take penalties. Note also: the goalkeeper who was in goal at the end of the game must be the keeper for the shoot-out. |
| 7 | The referees' and adjudicators' decisions are final. |
| 8 | All cases of misconduct will be reported to the county F.A. |

| 9 | Throw in: As normal football |
| 10 | Corner: As normal football |
| 11 | Offside: there is no offside |
| 12 | Free kick: All free kicks are indirect unless a penalty kick |
| 13 | Pass back: Pass back to the goalkeeper is allowed. Note: the keeper cannot kick the ball |
| 14 | A foul in the 'D' will result in a penalty kick being awarded |

| 15 | The goalkeeper can only throw the ball out (any method) |
| 16 | If the goalkeeper deliberately kicks the ball a free kick will be awarded outside the 'D' |
| 17 | If the goalkeeper comes outside the 'D' penalty area a penalty kick will be awarded |

| 19 | In the event of teams being tied on points after the preliminary round, qualification for the next round will be given to the team with the best goal difference. If still tied, the team with the best goals for and finally the team with the least goals against. If the teams are still tied then a penalty shoot-out will take place, the winner progressing to the next round |
| 20 | In the event of teams being tied after a final round, 2 minutes extra time played on way will take place, if the teams are still tied a penalty shoot-out will then take place |
| 21 | The draw for quarter finals and semi finals will be made on the day. The winners of each semi final will play each other in the final |
