We are again holding our Annual Football Tournament; this will take place over the weekend of the 3rd and 4th July 2010 @ Lancashire Police Headquarters Hutton.

Format as Follows : **PLEASE NOTE : AGE GROUPS AS PER SEASON 10/11**

Sat 3rd July 09:30 - 13:00 Under 9's, 15's
Sat 3rd July 13:45 - 17:00 Under 10's, 16's
Sun 4th July 9:30 - 13:00 Under 11's, 13's
Sun 4th July 13:45 - 17:00 Under 12's, 14's

There will be 4 groups of 6 teams per age group. Each team will have 5 games of 8 minutes with the top 2 teams from each group moving onto Quarter Finals, Semi Finals and a Final.

Teams will be made up of :

Under 9's - 11's will be 7 a side with 2 substitutes (9 Registered Players)
Under 12's - 16's will be 6 a side with 2 substitutes (8 Registered Players)

The cost per team is £30, and places are restricted to 24 teams per age group, so it is advisable to get your entries in as soon as possible.

From the feedback from last years tournament, ALL WINNERS AND RUNNERS UP will be presented with a Trophy to keep.

Refreshments will be available over the weekend.

Lancon JFC Summer Tournament Rules

- All players must be of the required age for their age group as of the 2010/2011 season. All players' names, date of birth and current school year must be submitted at registration on the form provided. These are for use by Lancon JFC only.
- Players can only play for one team. Any player found to be playing for more than one team will be excluded from the remainder of the event and the team(s) will also be liable to exclusion at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
- For age groups of Under 9's, 10's and 11's teams can have a maximum of 9 players per squad, with 7 players participating from the start of a game.
- For age groups U12-U16's teams can have a maximum of 8 players per squad with 6 players participating from the start of the game.
- Substitutions can be made at any time with the referees consent. Substitutions shall be roll-on roll-off. Players who have been sent off cannot be substituted.
- All group games, Quarter Finals and Semi Finals shall be 8 minutes one way. The Final will be 10 minutes, 5 minutes each way with a 1 minute interval.
- In the Quarter Finals, Semi-finals and Final if the game should end level then 4 minutes extra time with the Golden Goal Rule shall be played. If the game is still level then a penalty shoot-out in accordance with the laws of the game shall determine the winner.
- Any team not ready to play at the scheduled time shall concede a goal and start the game 1-0 down. If a team is 2 minutes or more late to the start of their scheduled game they will forfeit the game 3-0.
- In group games 3 points shall be awarded for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss. Should teams finish level on points then **goals scored** shall determine the positions. If teams are still level then **goal difference**. If teams are still level then the winners of the game between the two teams shall be placed highest. In the unlikely event that teams are still equal then a penalty shoot out will take place.

- The game will start with the designated home team having kick off. After every goal the game shall restart with a centre kick-off. Throw-ins and corners are to be taken in accordance with the laws of the game. The ball is permitted to go above head height. There shall be no offside.
- All out-field players **ARE** allowed into the penalty area. Goalkeepers **ARE NOT** allowed outside the penalty area, this will result in a penalty being awarded. Goalkeepers **ARE** permitted to use their feet, however goalkeepers must throw the ball back into play once they have control of the ball (Under 9's and 10's Goalkeepers will be permitted to Kick.). Breach of this will also result in a penalty. Goalkeepers can pick up any back passes made by a team mate. There shall be no goal kicks and the ball must be thrown back into play. (Under 9's and 10's Goalkeepers will be permitted to Kick.)
- All free kicks are direct. Opponents must be at least 3 yards away from the ball. Offences committed inside a player's own penalty area will result in a penalty.
- Any player who is cautioned is sin binned for 2minutes. Any player who is sent off shall miss the remainder of the game and all of the next game.
- *The referee's decision is final.*
- Boots or trainers may be worn. All players must wear shin guards.
- In the event of a colour clash the team named second on the fixtures shall change their tops, the wearing of bibs is allowed.
- Any protest regarding a match must be placed before the tournament committee within 5 minutes of the end of the match in question.
